- I am pursuing an artistic curriculum at secondary level and regularly practice artistic expression.
- I have good general and artistic knowledge: I regularly frequent cultural facilities (theatres, museums, cinemas, etc.).
- I have a good grasp of literary disciplines.
- I am competent with techniques of written and oral expression.
- I enjoy reading and writing.
- Candidates should ideally have a background in literary studies, economics & social studies or science.

Most of the professions listed require master's level qualifications, but some of them can be accessed after 2 or 3 years' higher education.

POST-SECONDARY COURSES AVAILABLE AT THE UNIVERSITY OF LILLE

3-YEAR BACHELOR'S DEGREE

Theoretical grounding to prepare for further study up to master's level and/or civil service examinations.

DEGREE ARTS A OPTION PLASTIC ARTS D

This course is more theoretical than practical, with a focus on art history and the development of critical thought while at the same time pursuing personal artistic expression. It addresses both theoretical and practical dimensions of contemporary art and offers students a broad understanding of the artistic world and a chance to develop their capacity for expression through plastic arts.

DEGREE ARTS A OPTION STAGE ARTS

This course invites students to discover the world of drama or furtherdevelop their dramatic skills.It addresses both theory and practice and provides a solid grounding in the stage arts, exploring various schools and genres of drama.

DEGREE ARTS A OPTION CINEMATOGRAPHIC STUDIES C

From the Lumière brothersto Chaplin and Brian De Palma, and from directing a short film to scriptwriting (documentaries and fiction), this course provides a theoretical grounding in the history and aesthetics of cinema and introduces students to the many different approaches adopted (aesthetic, historical, anthropological, sociological, philosophical, economics, etc.).

DEGREE ARTS A OPTION DANCE STUDIES Selective programme

This course combines students' practical experience with a solid grounding in choreography, exploring the fundamentals of both practice and theory (choreographic analysis, history of dance and music, analysing movement, anatomy, fundamentals of stage styles, etc.) as well as culture, expression and reflection (art theory, dance aesthetics, critical writing on dance, etc.).

DEGREE ARTS (A) OPTION MUSIC & MUSICOLOGY (C) SELECTIVE

PROGRAMME

This course offers both technical subjects (listening, writing, analysis) and musicology (with an introduction to ethno -musicology). It offers both a theoretical and practical approach to contemporary instrumental expression, electroacoustic music (electroacoustic innovation, sound design) and multimedia expression (art and technology).

Selective admission, reserved for studentsalso enrolled on a specialist or advanced programme at the Conservatoire.

Selective admission, reserved for holders of the EAT (technical aptitude examination) and registered for the state dance teaching diploma.

Selective admission, reserved for studentswho have completed their 1st year on the DUMI programme. Successful graduates will hold both the DUMI and an Arts degree.

DUMI - UNIVERSITY DIPLOMA IN MUSIC

AFTER 1 YEAR IN HIGHER EDUCATION

2-year course to prepare for a career as a music instructor (in nursery & primary schools, music schools, community centres, etc.). Admission subject to validation and entrance tests.
