POST-SECONDARY COURSES AVAILABLE AT THE UNIVERSITY OF LILLE

### 3-YEAR BACHELOR'S DEGREE

Theoretical grounding to prepare for further study up to master's level and/or civil service examinations.

DEGREE **AES**  

The **degree in Economic and Social Administration (AES)** is a multidisciplinary course structured around two different knowledge and skill sets: Law and Economics. As well as this core teaching, students benefit from an introduction to other connected areas: management science, political science, human and social science, and statistics.

This course will equip students with an analytical mindset and the capacity to solve problems using the tools developed in law and economics.

The first year includes broad coursework, while the second consolidates what students have learned, before specialising in the third year in business administration and management or public administration and economics.

Another unique option is available to students:

DEGREE **AES** OPTION **ESJ LILLE**  **[UNIQUE IN FRANCE]** SELECTIVE PROGRAMME

Course enabling students to take bachelor's degree modules at the University as well as classes at the École Supérieure de Journalisme in Lille (ESJ Lille) with a view to preparing for the entrance examinations at schools of journalism. Candidates must apply for both the AES degree programme (ESJ Lille option) and directly via [esj-lille.fr/](https://www.esj-lille.fr/).

### AFTER 2 YEARS OF HIGHER EDUCATION

Whatever your background, you have the option of completing professional training. This course lasts one year and allows you to specialise, obtain a dual qualification or enter the job market after 3 years in higher education. This professional diploma is designed to lead immediately to employment.

### AFTER A BACHELOR'S DEGREE

You can continue your studies to master's level (5 years in higher education), opting for example for the AES Master's programme, which is a direct and natural extension of the AES degree programme, or alternatively law (Master's programmes include social law, public law and business Law), public administration or political science.

You can also sit civil service examinations (teaching, social work, regional authorities) or the entrance examinations for specialist schools (e.g. journalism).
